

**Requirements for the application for Full Professorship in Philosophy at the Faculty of Humanities, Charles University.**

1. The candidate submits a list of a minimum of 40 publications, out of which at least 15 are international/foreign language publications. The minimum required number of publications can only include those where the candidate is the sole or principal author. The candidate for a full professorship in the field of humanities is an author of at least one monograph.
2. The candidate submits a list of a minimum of 25 citations in scholarly foreign publications. Reviews can be included in the list, provided that they were published in scholarly journals or books. The candidate must indicate the method of citation search
3. The candidate's academic career to date should include extended professional experience abroad.
4. The candidate is a supervisor of doctoral students, at least one of whom has already graduated; an advisor ("konzultant") who is demonstrably involved in the preparation of the doctoral student throughout the entire period of study is also considered a supervisor in this context
