## Requirements for the application for Full Professorship in Social, Cultural and Historical Anthropology at the Faculty of Humanities, Charles University

## <u>Discipline-specific requirements of the Faculty of Humanities (FH CU):</u>

- FH CU requires that the candidates have a minimum of 40 publications, out of which at least 15 are published by a foreign publisher. Publication activity in the field of the procedure must include at least 6 articles in journals maintained in the Web of Science database (Jimp), two of which in Q1-Q2 journals according to WoS, or 3 independent book monographs (B). Alternatively, the candidate can present 3 Jimp articles (1 of which in Q1-Q2) and 1 monograph. For each study published in Q1 or Q2 according to WoS or for a scientific monograph in a foreign language published in a major foreign publishing house, the total number of publications required by Charles University will be reduced by one.
- A minimum of 40 citations is required for the appointment procedure, of which at least 25
  are foreign/international citations. Reviews can be included in the overview of citations,
  provided that they have been published in scholarly journals. The candidate must specify
  the methodology for citations search
- The candidate has been an investigator of at least two external scientific research projects; management of international projects is desirable
- An internship at a foreign research institute for a minimum of 6 months (or a maximum of 3 separate internships for a total of 6 months) is required for the appointment procedure. The internship may be replaced by joint publications with a foreign co-author, the candidate must submit 5 such publications.
